



Shallow Geothermal Energy Resource Project - Consultation

The Geological Survey of Ireland (GSI) is undertaking a project on the shallow geothermal energy resources of Ireland. SLR Consulting Ireland and Arup have been contracted to undertake this work. The aim of the project is to produce:

- best practice guidance for the geothermal systems in Ireland. Guidance will be provided to installers, drillers, local authorities and government agencies to inform the regulatory functions, as well as to allow users to understand the necessary requirements for installing geothermal systems. This guidance will potentially inform professional certification in the future;
- suitability maps for the utilisation of shallow geothermal energy resources; and
- a database of existing systems.
